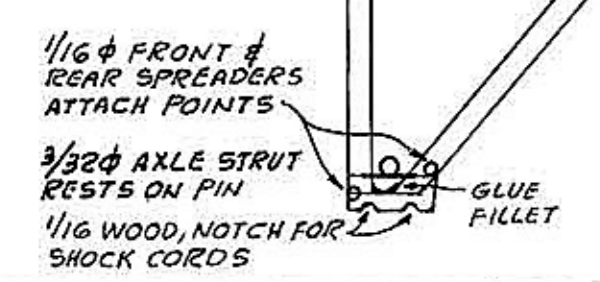

COLORING:
 OVERALL ALUMINUM FINISH. UNDER SURFACES OF BOTH WINGS, HORIZONTAL TAIL & FUSELAGE NATURAL LINEN. MAIN L.G. LEGS ALUMINUM COLOR. CABANE & INTERPLANE STRUTS MEDIUM DARK WOOD COLOR. AILERON ROD & TAIL SKID, STEEL COLOR. BLUE IN FRENCH MARKINGS IS DARK BLUE, BRITISH MEDIUM TO LIGHT BLUE.

TRY TO MAINTAIN FINISHED MODEL WEIGHT, EXCLUSIVE OF RUBBER MOTOR, BETWEEN 11/4 OZ TO NOT MORE THAN 11/2 OZ.
 SUGGESTED MOTOR 10 TO 12 STRANDS OF 1/8 TO FORM 5 TO 6 LOOPS ABOUT 14 TO 15" LONG, BRAID/PLAIT TO FINAL 7 1/2 TO 8" LENGTH.

ABOUT 7000 NIEUPORT A/C WERE PRODUCED 1915 TO 1918. THE NI 17 C1 WAS ONE OF THE MOST FAMOUS, AND MADE ITS FIRST APPEARANCE AT THE FRONT ON 2 MAY 1916 WITH THE FRENCH 57TH ESCADRILLE, THIS TYPE A/C ALSO SERVED WITH THE R.F.C., ITALIANS, AND AMERICAN UNITS, & OTHERS.
