
AMATEUR DESIGNER

- 2. Make pencil lines dark, or use ball point pen.
- 3. Write a short letter or article telling how the model flies, how you arrived at this design, something about yourself (age, school or occupation, interests).
- 4. Send photo of you and the model together.
- 5. This department open to all types of models.
