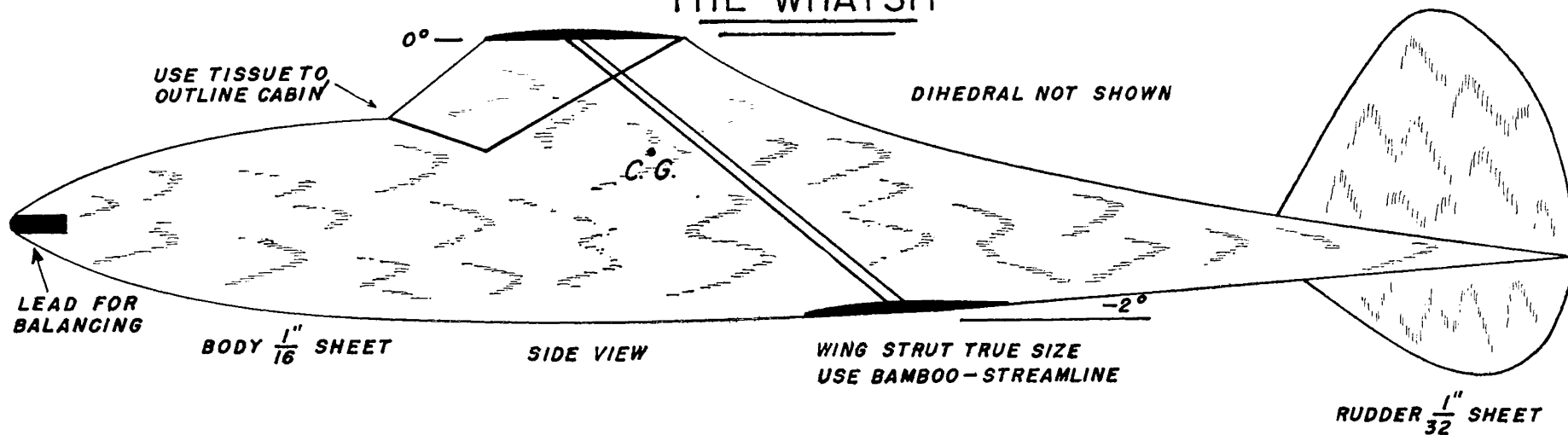


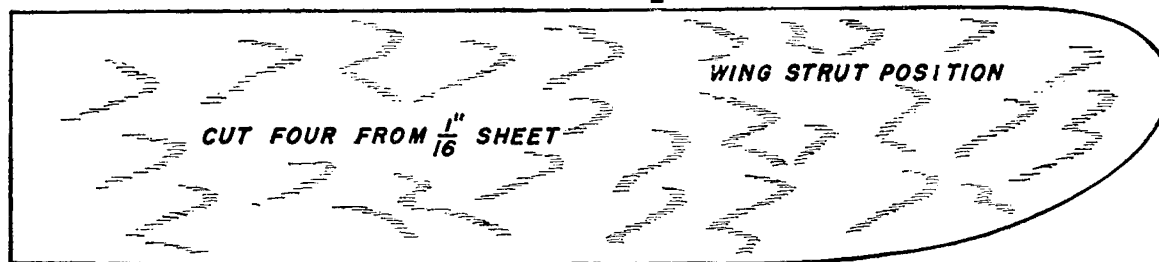
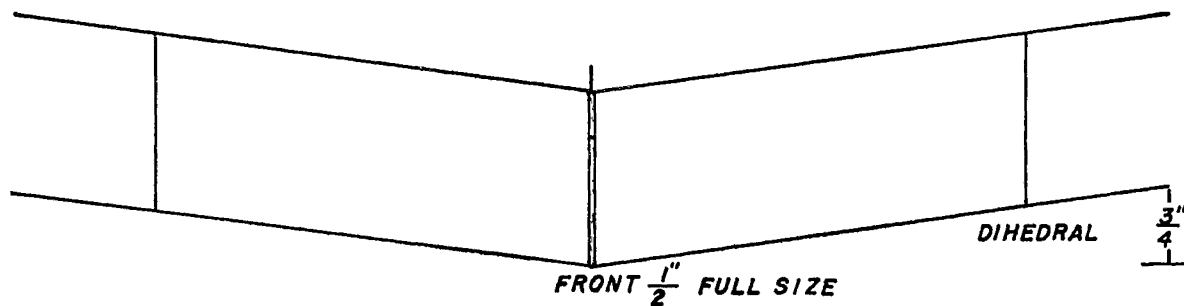
THE WHATSIT

SCALE FULL SIZE, EXCEPT WHEN SHOWN
USE HARD Balsa THROUGHOUT
DIHEDRAL SAME IN EACH WING
TREAT LOWER WING AS STABILIZER
DOPE ALL PARTS FOUR TIMES



A unique biplane glider with large positive stagger and a decalage. The stagger is so great that it is hard to determine whether the lower wing should be classified as part of the biplane combination, or a stabilizer. Structurally it is a biplane; functionally the lower wing is a stabilizer.

This plane is one of the steadiest fliers ever designed, believe it or not.
