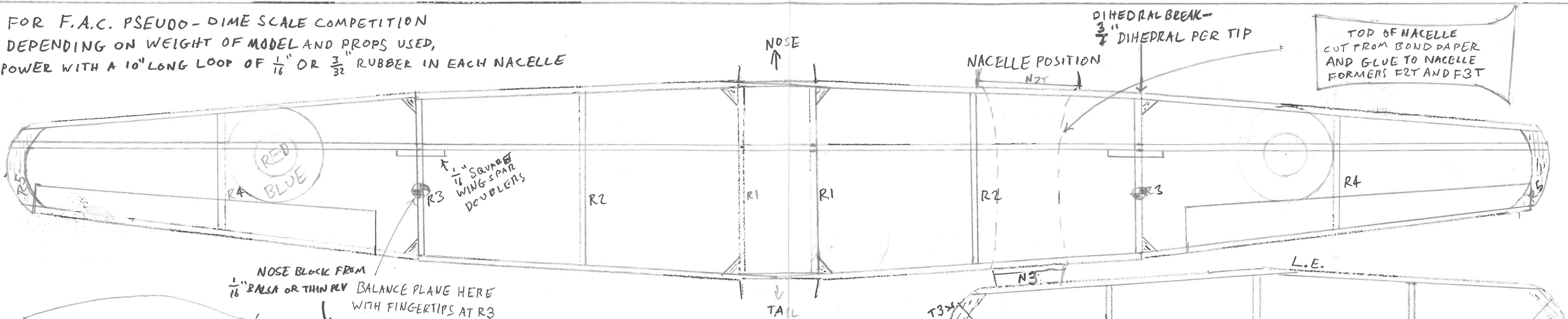


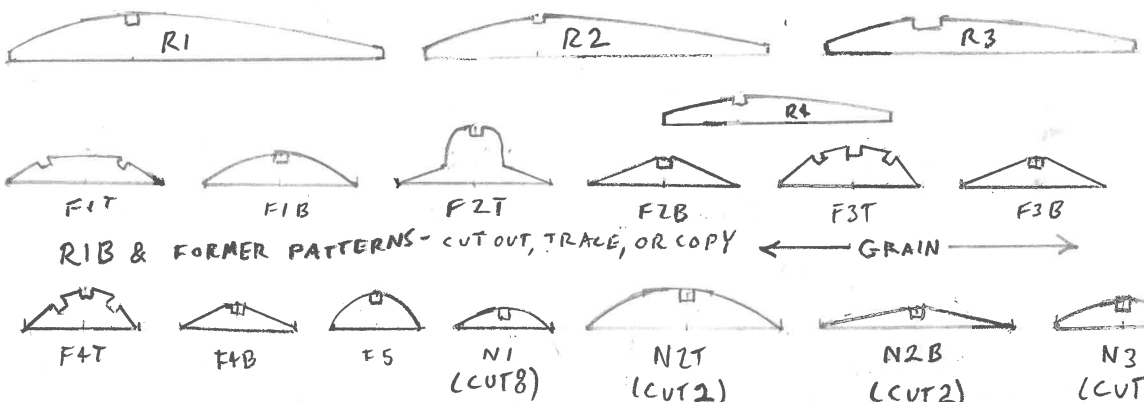
FOR F.A.C. PSEUDO-DIME SCALE COMPETITION

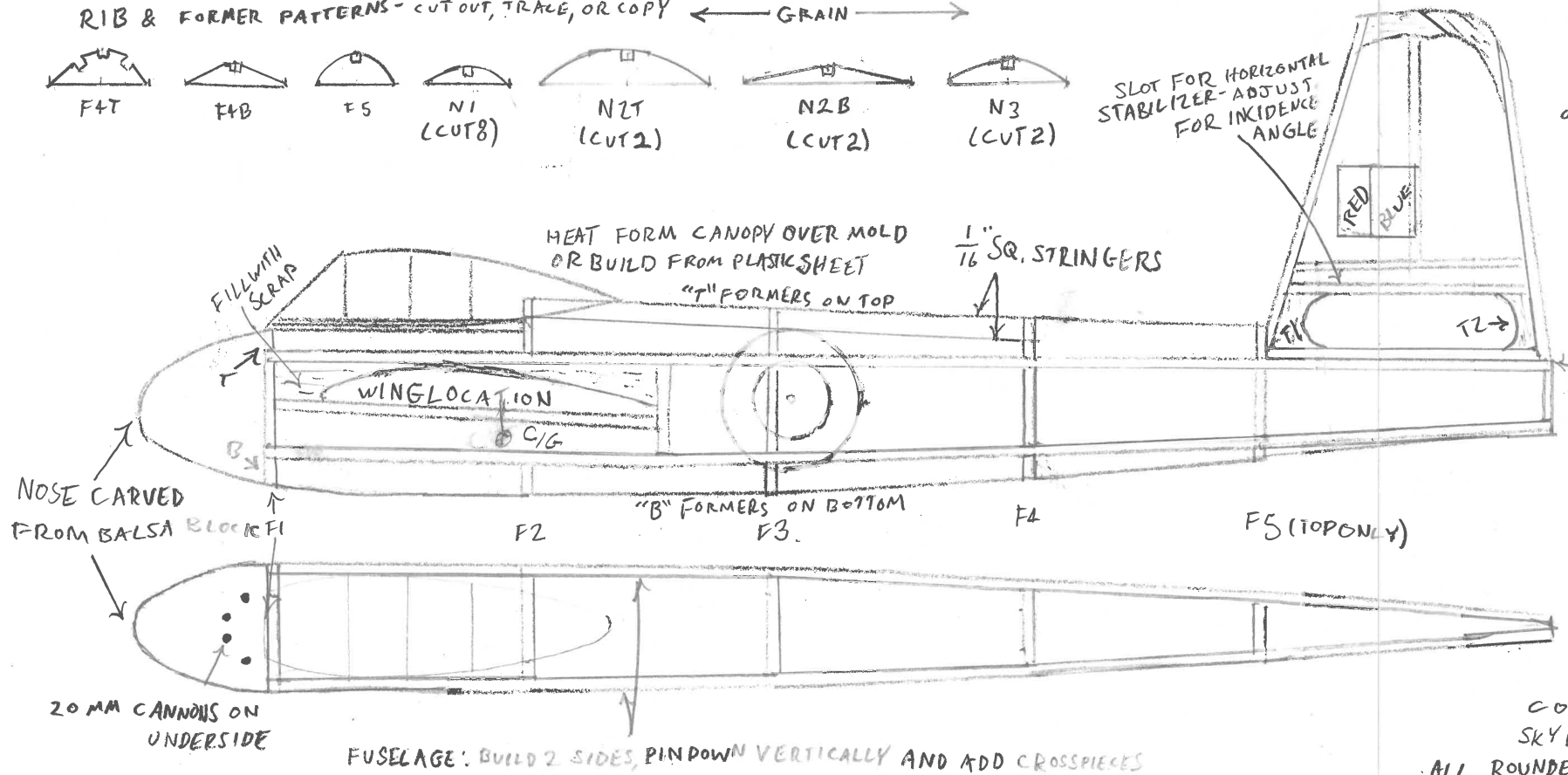
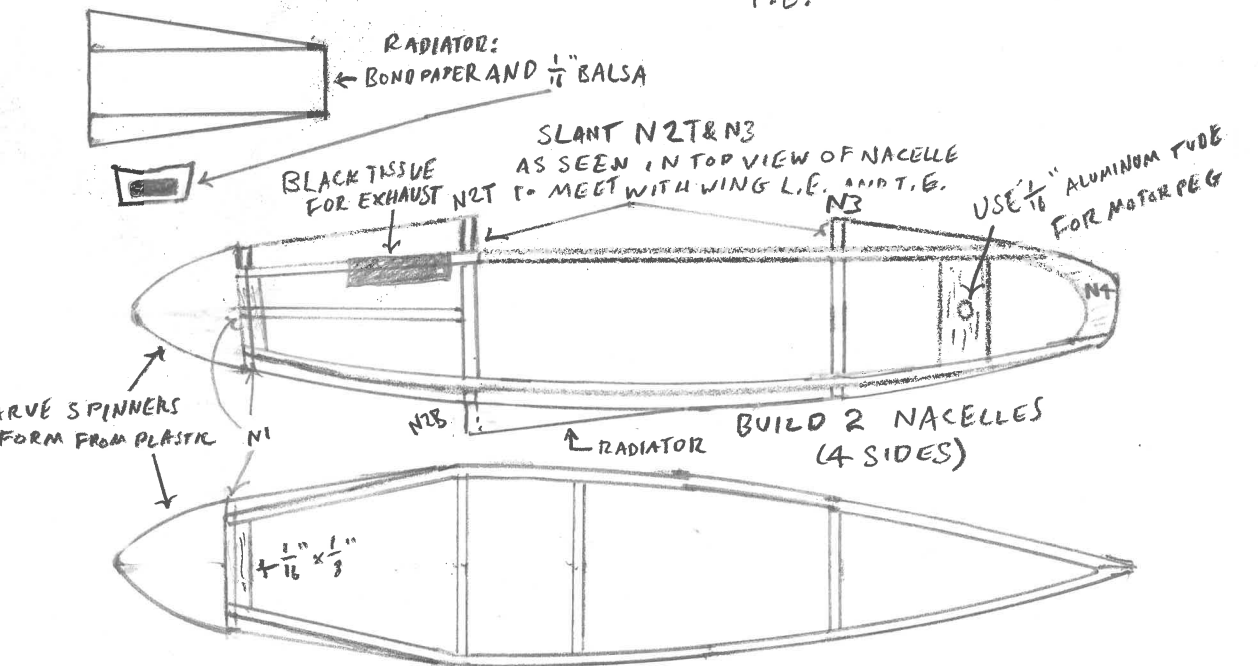
NOSE BLOCK FROM $\frac{1}{16}$ " Balsa or thin ply

WELKIN MK.1 HAD A LENGTH OF 41.5 FT, 70 FT WINGSPAN AND WAS POWERED BY 2 ROLLS-ROYCE MERLIN 76/77 LIQUID-COOLED 1,233 HP PISTON ENGINES. ITS RANGE WAS 1,480 MILES, MAX. SPEED 385 MPH, AND ITS SERVICE CEILING WAS 45,000 FT. THIS ALTITUDE REQUIRED BOTH A PRESSURIZED COCKPIT AND AN OXYGEN MASK FOR THE SINGLE-PILOT CREW
